USE OF MAGIC WORDS EXCUSE ME, SORRY, THANKS, PLEASE

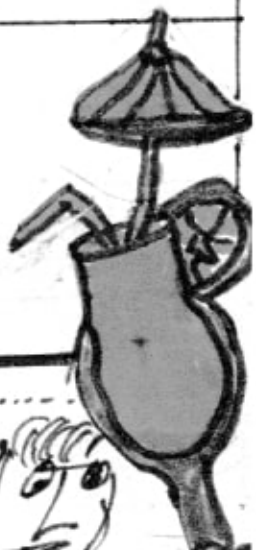
- ❖ When asking for something say 'Please'
